

# THE MUNICIPALITY OF LOUISE

## By-law 2016-9

### Being A By-law of the Municipality of Louise to Regulate And Establish Reduced-Speed School Zone Areas on Designated Highways

Whereas Section 98.1 of The Highway Traffic Act and the Reduced-Speed School Zones Regulation No.136/2013 authorize a municipality to pass a by-law establishing reduced maximum permitted speed for vehicles being driven on a highway within a school zone within the geological limits of the municipality;

And whereas the Municipality of Louise deems it advisable and in the best interests of the Municipality to establish reduced-speed school zones with a reduced maximum speed for vehicles.

Now therefore the Municipality of Louise enacts as a by-law the following:

1. Short title

That this by-law may be called the: Reduced-Speed School Zone By-law.

2. Interpretation

That for the purposes of this By-law, "highway", "reduced-speed school zone", "school", "traffic control device", and "vehicle" has the same meanings as set out in The Highway Traffic Act and the Reduced-Speed School Regulation No. 136/2013 and as amended from time to time.

3. Reduced-Speed School Zones


That the reduced-speed school limit for vehicles pertains to the travelled portion of the highway within 150 meters along the highway in either direction beyond the limits of the land used for the purposes of the schools as a school zone during the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m., Monday to Friday.

That the reduced-speed school limit of 30 kilometers per hour is in effect from September 1 to June 30 excluding weekends.

4. Traffic Control Devices

That the Municipality shall identify the reduced-speed School Zones Regulation No. 136/2013.
