MUNICIPALITY OF LOUISE **CLOSE PUBLIC RESERVE** BY-LAW NO. 2021-08

Being a By-law of the Municipality of Louise to close public reserve, pursuant to Section 139(1) of the Planning Act.

WHEREAS, Section 139(1) of The Planning Act provides as follows:

Closing public reserve land

'Subject to subsection (2) a municipality may close public reserve land by

a) Passing a by-law to close the public reserve land;

- b) Obtaining written approval of the by-law from the minister; and
- c) Registering the approved by-law and, if required by a district registrar, a plan in the appropriate land titles office'.

AND WHEREAS the following described public reserve is no longer required for public purposes and it is desirable and expedient and in the public interest that the same be closed;

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the Municipality of Louise, in meeting duly assembled enacts as follows

- 1. That all that portion of the public lane shown as Parcel 'A' on a Plan of Survey, being
- part of the NE 1/4 24-3-12 WPM, prepared by Jesse Paul Simon Carels, Manitoba Land Surveyor, certified by him on the 17th day of May 2021 and on deposit with the Morden Land Titles Office as Deposit No 0281/2021 (hereinafter referred to as Parcel 'A') be and the same is hereby closed.
- 2. That, subject to paragraph 3 herein, all that portion of Parcel 'A' so closed, EXCEPTING thereout all mines and minerals and other matters as reserved in the Crown Lands Act, shall be transferred to the registered owner of the adjacent land described as: LOTS 20, 21, 22, 24 AND 25 PLAN 760 MLTO IN NE ¼ 24-3-12 WMC and consolidated with their title;
- 3. That the proper officers of the municipality are hereby authorized and directed to do all acts and execute all documents required for the purpose of implementing the said closing and transfer; and
- 4. That this By-law shall be valid and in effect on, from and after the day it receives approval of the Minister by written order.
