Supply of Fire Tanker Apparatus

The Municipality of Louise invites qualified suppliers to submit sealed tenders for the supply of a new or used Fire Tanker Apparatus meeting the specifications outlined in this Request for Tender.

1. Scope of Supply

The Municipality is seeking the purchase of one (1) Fire Tanker Apparatus consisting of a tanker body mounted on a suitable commercial chassis and equipped for municipal fire protection operations.

The successful bidder shall provide a complete, operational unit meeting all applicable Canadian safety standards and Manitoba regulations.

2. Tank and Body Specifications

The tanker body shall include the following minimum specifications:

- New or used 3,000 Imperial gallon Polypropylene Elliptical Tank
- Tank and body constructed of:
 - 3/4" Polypropylene material
 - 1/2" Polypropylene material
- Primed and painted finish to match chassis color
- 6" internal vent
- Scene light mounting brackets
- Beacon light mounting brackets
- Polypropylene conduit for electrical wiring
- Hot-dip galvanized sub-frame
- Tank mounted:
 - Spring-mounted to chassis at front
 - Spring-mounted to chassis at center
 - Solid mounted at rear

- Portable water pond storage provisions, including secure storage, mounting, and access for a portable water pond suitable for fire tanker operations.
- PTO-driven fire pump capability on the truck, including details on pump capacity, controls, plumbing, valves, and any required chassis or drivetrain provisions.

3. Additional Information Required

- Emergency lighting details
- Electronic water gauge details
- Tank opening details
- Apparatus body accessories
- Dump valve details
- Chassis details
- Other miscellaneous items
- Training, if provided
- Warranty options

4. Pricing

Bidders shall provide pricing in the following format:

- Base tender price, showing taxes if applicable.
- Separate pricing for PTO/fire pump equipment and installation, if not included in the base tender price.
- Separate optional pricing for a built-in fire pump mounted on the truck, including all related plumbing, controls, valves, mounting, and commissioning.

Bidders shall indicate:

- Estimated delivery date
- Delivery location
- Any additional freight or delivery charges
