

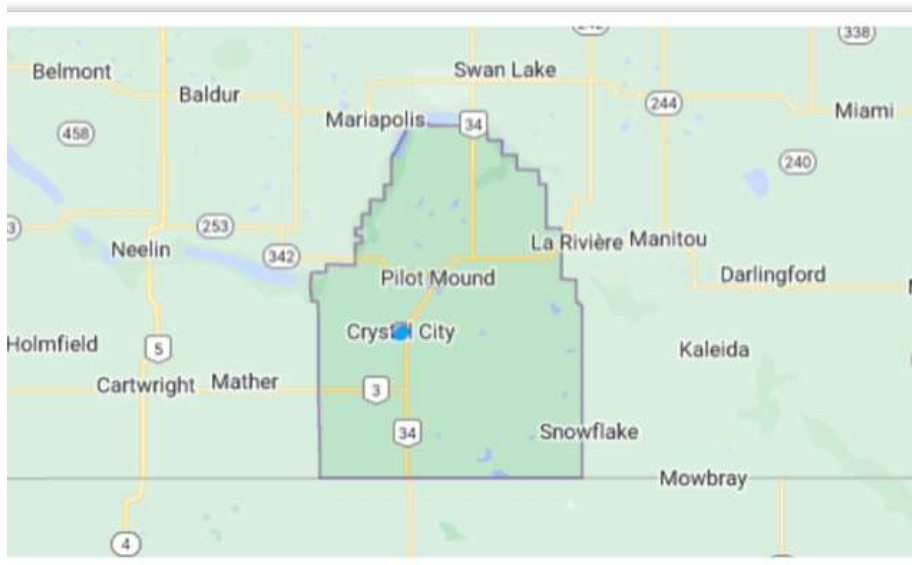

Municipality of Louise:

The Municipality of Louise is located in Central Manitoba, 148 km southwest of Manitoba's capital city of Winnipeg and 105 km southeast of Manitoba's second largest city, Brandon. The Municipality of Louise shares its border with the USA, the Municipality of Cartwright-Roblin, the Municipality of Pembina, the Municipality of Argyle and the Municipality of Lorne. The local urban districts of Clearwater, Crystal City, and Pilot Mound are the communities within Louise. Many families in Louise value the quiet country lifestyle. Outdoor sports enthusiasts appreciate the excellent snowmobiling, fishing, and hunting in various spots within Louise. Golfers can enjoy the community owned 9 hole golf course. Recreational facilities are well maintained and actively used by many. When you are thinking about locating or expanding your business, the Municipality of Louise is well worth your consideration. The Municipality of Louise Council, local Chamber of Commerce's and Louise Community Development Corporation are all committed to further economic and residential development of their community and all welcome investors, businesses and new residents.



Pilot Mound

Pilot Mound is an unincorporated community recognized as a local urban district that also once held town status in the Canadian province of Manitoba. It is located within the Municipality of Louise approximately 60 km west of the City of Morden. Pilot Mound has a population of approximately 700 people. The rolling landscape and nearby lakes provide excellent hunting and fishing, as well as summer and winter recreation for snowmobile, ATV, water-skiing, snow skiing, boating, and cross-country skiing. Water is supplied from the Glenora aquifer through pipeline to Pilot Mound with a reverse osmosis membrane unit, making this some of the best drinking water in southern Manitoba. Moundfest is an annual festival that brings in people from all over the province for the slow pitch tournament, beer gardens and live music. Pilot Mound also hosts an annual curling bonspiel, bi-annual community auction, triathlon and more. The town has a first class arena complex with ice surface, curling facility, daycare, theatre, museum and a hockey academy. Pilot Mound also has an art center, library, community hall, grocery stores, swimming pool, care home, apartments, public health, hardware stores, gas stations, hotel, restaurants, pharmacy, bakery, funeral home, tire shop, school, insurance office, post office, camp ground and more.

Crystal City

Crystal City is an unincorporated community recognized as a local urban district in the Municipality of Louise within the Canadian province of Manitoba. It held village status prior to January 1, 2015. The "Friendly Southern City" runs aside the most southern end of highway #3, being only a 10 minute drive from the United States border. Population has increased by 1.3 % according to the census data, with a population of about 400 people now. With friendly neighbours you don't have to worry about your children walking to and from the schools. The town has a local theatre for live performances, a grocery store, clothing store, a restaurant, a coffee shop, 55+ activity center, parks, arena, ball diamonds, hiking trails, cross country skiing trails, a bank, lawyers office, insurance office, post office, camp ground, hospital, schools, daycare, doctor's office, churches and more. In the winter, enjoy a skating trail on the Crystal City Creek and take in the beautiful scenery. In the summer, events such as the 4-H fair and demolition derby are held for you and your family to enjoy.

Clearwater

Clearwater is an unincorporated community recognized as a local urban district in south central Manitoba. It is located in the Municipality of Louise. It plays host to the Harvest Moon Festival each September, a music and organic farming event which swells the community to over 3000 for three days. July 1st. Clearwater annual baseball tournament is a big draw for the community increasing its population from 80 to over 1000 for the event. A close knit community with a local grocery store and restaurant, hiking trails, rental facilities, event center, church, community hall, curling club and skating arena, and ball diamonds. Take a walk down a side street and see two beautiful 100-year-old churches. St. Paul's Anglican Church was built in 1889 and its interior remains untouched by redecoration or design. Just a few steps away is the former Knox United Church, which was built in 1893 at a cost of \$1,625.00. Enjoy some scenery of the valley on the cross country ski trails in the winter, or by taking a walk over Clearwater's old railway bridge that is now called the Skywalk Bridge.

Tourism Spots in the Municipality of Louise:

Crystal City Printing Museum

218 Broadway St. S, Crystal City, MB



This designated Heritage Site Building is probably the oldest in town, built about 1880. As you walk through the door, the wonderful sounds and ink and oil smells of the original printing and typesetting machines fill the air. You'll feel as if you could actually be back in 1881 when publisher Thomas Greenway and Co. issued their first "Rock Lake Herald", later to become the Crystal City Courier. The Museum is completely operational and you'll see the presses in action, learn about the painstaking printing processes, and even take home a memento of your visit.

Manitoba WW1 Museum

Get a sense what life was like in the Great War. A simulated 150 meter Trench System allows visitors to experience WWI warfare as it was. A seasonal Exhibit shows the training of the soldier here in Canada. An authentic Trench Headquarters is also recreated behind the Front Line. This unique Museum follows Manitoban soldiers from Training to Overseas. A collection of uniforms, medals, photographs along with original artifacts fill the Museum.

Star Mound

SE 27-1-10 WPM Snowflake, MB



Known by a variety of names including Nebogwawin Butte and Merry Dance Hill, the Star Mound is a 100-foot-tall, ice-age moraine in southern Manitoba that arises abruptly from the surrounding prairie, west of Snowflake in the Municipality of Louise. A former schoolhouse (1886) with text books and records, the Star Mound School Museum is located in a park noted for spring crocuses. A sacred Aboriginal site is also located here.

Thomas Greenway Cemetery

Crystal City, MB

The Thomas Greenway Cemetery, a family burial site in an open agricultural setting, is the final resting place of Thomas Greenway (1838-1908), premier of Manitoba from 1888 to 1900, whose contributions included reform of the provincial school system, promotion of railway building and settlement, service as Minister of Agriculture and steps to reorganize provincial politics on a more partisan basis. Located north of Rock Lake Hospital.



The Old Mound

2 Miles NW of Pilot Mound, MB



The 'Old Mound' first became settled in 1878. Pilot Mound takes its name from the fact that the mound of shale that rises prominently above the surrounding landscape served as a 'pilot' or landmark for the early fur traders, settlers and explorers. While on the treeless prairie of the early days, the mound could be seen from a great distance. A stone vault used to store Land Titles documents stands on the southeast corner of the old mound.



Lessons from the Land Trail

Clearwater, MB

The Lessons from the Land interpretive trail is a pleasant 2.3 km (1.4 mi.) walk through scenic vistas of the Cypress Creek valley, in Clearwater Manitoba. The trail's nine themed interpretive stops weave a story of the Valley and the interaction between its creek, flora, fauna and people. Self-guided trail brochures document the changes to the creek throughout the history of the small town.



Skywalk Bridge

Clearwater, MB

Built in the 1980s, the once used bridge for the rail line is now decommissioned. Take a walk along the bridge and enjoy the beautiful scenery of the little valley and creek the bridge runs over.



Crystal City Reservoir

Crystal City, MB



In the spring, summer and fall months, enjoy hiking trails and the beautiful scenery. In the winter, thanks to all the hard work of locals, there is now an incredible skating trail and open rink spots available for all to use and enjoy. You can skate for quite a distance and enjoy the river bank and views along the way. There are benches set up so you can put on and take off your skates and gear. One visit will show you how active this little area is, there are snowshoe tracks and cross country ski trails everywhere, the blade marks all over the ice showing the miles that have put on by many skaters. Boot marks up and down the creek. All too often small rural communities have sweet spots like this and just don't have the marketing dollars and people in place in order to highlight them and show them off. So share this with your friends and help spread the word about this gem that we have here in the Municipality of Louise.

Goudney Reservoir

West of Pilot Mound, MB



Fishing, hunting, education and fun. Mound Wildlife is an active organization in the Municipality of Louise that manages the Goudney Reservoir just a short jaunt west of Pilot Mound. Ice fishing and regular fishing are the highlights for this spot but canoeing, kayaking, hiking, swimming and biking are all apart of the landscape. Mound Wildlife stocks the reservoir with yellow perch, northern pike and walleye.

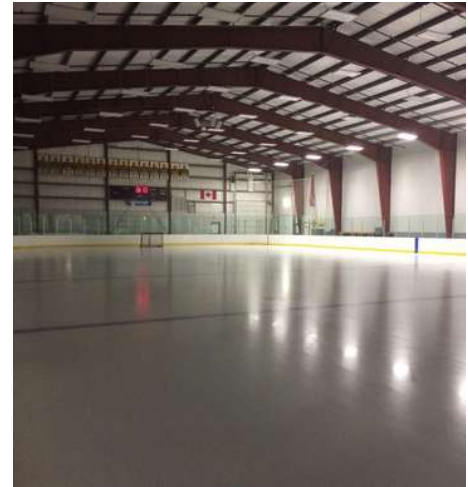

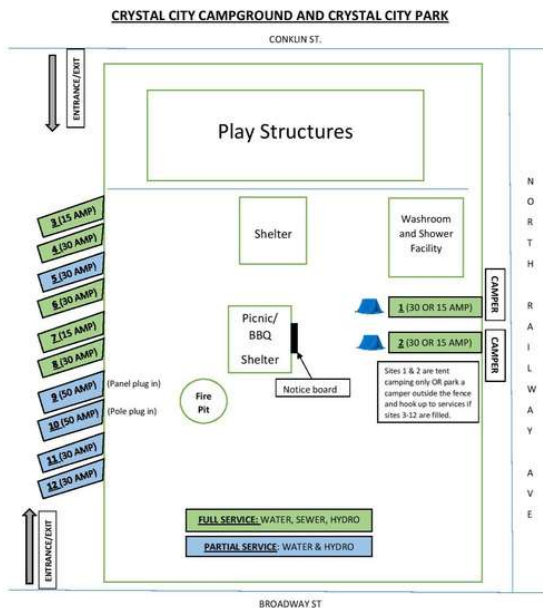

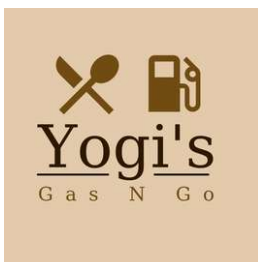

Harvest Moon Festival

Clearwater, MB

The Harvest Moon Festival celebrates the harvest season and local food production, while providing an opportunity to link those from rural and urban communities.
